

I own an older home in a popular inner-city neighbourhood. A builder knocked on my front door and asked me if I'd be willing to sell - he said I'll get more money for my home if we don't get a real estate professional involved. What should I do?

What you're describing is not an unusual situation, particularly in large cities where inner city property is attractive, particularly to builders who want to redevelop it.

The first step is to decide if you have any interest in selling. If you don't want to sell, no matter the offer price, then your conversation with the builder is likely done.

On the other hand, if there is a price at which you would consider selling, you have some due diligence to do.

Even if the builder suggested you don't involve a licensed real estate professional, our advice is always to have a real estate professional involved, who will work on your behalf.

There's a good chance the builder doesn't want you to get a real estate professional involved because they think they may have an easier time negotiating with you, assuming you do not have much experience in the real estate market. They're trying to sweeten the deal by saying you'll get more money for your property if you don't hire a real estate professional; the thought being that if you don't hire a real estate professional, you won't have to pay commissions to the real estate professional, and you can keep more money in your pocket.

My caution for you on this is that they're saying they'll pay you more - but more than what? More than what they would pay you otherwise? More than your home is worth?

Everything is relative.

If you want to hire a real estate professional to represent you, you will have to sign a service agreement with them and it will indicate the details of the compensation you will owe to them, but that doesn't automatically mean you're going to end up with less money in your pocket from the builder.

With solid negotiating skills, your real estate professional may be able to negotiate a higher price from the builder, and still leave more money in your pocket after you pay your real estate professional's commission.

There are always benefits to working with a licensed professional; they're educated, regulated, they carry errors and omissions insurance, and the Real Estate Council of Alberta can investigate conduct if you believe they breach the rules in place.







Napa is a premier wine destination these days, so much so that many think it is too pretentious to allow little ones to visit. During a recent trip there, I found this not to be the case.

My companions were a young couple and their four-year-old son, who was filled with energy and an unparalleled love of all things Lego and Star Wars. We pulled up to the gates of Inglenook Vineyards, one of the elite producers in the Napa Valley. The fact that there was a security guard at the gate to check our reservation left me feel-

ing a bit anxious. Did we have the only guest carrying a Chewbacca action figure?

Inglenook was established by Finnish Sea Captain Gustave Niebaum in 1879 and was noted for producing wines to rival the best in the world. Prohibition presented obvious challenges in the 1920's for the winery, but when movie director Francis Ford Coppola bought the property in 1975 the journey back to greatness began.

We pulled up to the moss-covered stone estate and were greeted by the hostesses in the foyer. We proceeded up the grand staircase to find an immaculately restored 1948 Tucker Motor Car. Our young companion wondered why a car was parked on the second floor of the big house.

In the tasting room, our party was served a spectacular flight of Inglenook's premiere Rubicon wines with a tumbler of apple juice. Led by an imaginative preschooler, it sailed in the courtyard fountain for at least an hour. 





# ECONOMIC CRIMES

Economic crimes are property offences, which victimize individuals or legal entities through the commission of criminal offences, such as theft, fraud, and fraud related offences.

#### The Typical Economic Crimes are:

- Secret shopper and money laundering scams,
- Credit card skimming
- · Fraudulent cheques

#### **How to Prevent Becoming a Victim:**

- Don't give out any personal or financial information over email or the phone. That's very seldom how a legitimate job application works.
- Never deposit someone else's cheque, or wire money to a person or place you do not personally know and trust. If you receive a cheque in the mail, attached to such a request, assume it's fraudulent.
- Look carefully at the language of the 'offer.' Errors in the grammar or spelling of the offer, large and small, can be a tip that the email originated from a country in which English is not a first language. Not all employers from non-English speaking countries are certain fakes, but the detail is common to scammers.
- Avoid companies that are located outside of the country that only offer foreign mailing addresses and phone numbers.
- Avoid companies that are located outside of the country that only offer foreign mailing addresses and phone numbers.
- Avoid companies that advertise in unreliable locations, such as classifieds, unsolicited emails, unsolicited letters, and online websites.

- Avoid secret/mystery shopper ads that demand money up front for training or signing up, or ones that pay you before completing any work.
- Avoid ad's that guarantee work without a screening process. Most legitimate providers are looking for something special and screen their applicants.

# What to do When You Become a Victim of an Economic Crime:

- Collect all the documents relating to the incident.
   This includes contracts, written agreements, and any other paper or digital information.
- Put together a written statement in chronological order with the following considerations:
- · What happened?
- · Where it happened?
- · How it happened?
- When it happened, and in what sequence?
- · Who was, and is, involved?
- If the offender is known to you, call 403-266-1234.
- If the offender is unknown, you may visit a district office to make a report. You must be properly prepared to speak with police, otherwise valuable time and leads will be lost. Correctly assemble a concise and organized account of what happened. If you have been caught in the middle, between the con artists and the investors, it can pinpoint the role you played, and why.
- Contact the right agency to report your type of crime. Jurisdiction is based on the type of crime, and where the crime took place.

# What to do When You Become a Victim of an Online Use of a Fraudulent Credit Card:

If someone uses a fraudulent credit card to buy an item from you through an online sale site, normally you cannot get the idem or money back. The merchant loses the goods or services sold, the payment, the fees for processing the payment, any currency conversion commissions, and the amount of the chargeback penalty.

#### You can Report if or Take Measures to Reduce Occurrences, Such as:

- · Contact the credit card company for use of fraudulent cards; and,
- Report it to police for documenting occurrence and file number.

To prevent being 'charged back' for fraud transactions, merchants can sign up for services offered by Visa and MasterCard called Verified by Visa and MasterCard SecureCode, under the umbrella term 3-D Secure. This requires consumers to add additional information to finalize and confirm a transaction.

#### By Merchants:

- PAN Truncation- nor displaying the full number on receipts.
- Tokenization, data security- not storing the full number in computer systems.
- · Requesting additional information, such as a PIN, Postal Code code, or Card Security Code

### **Reporting an Economic Crime:**

To report any type of fraud or theft:

- Calgary area: call 403-266-1234
- · Outside of Calgary: contact the appropriate jurisdiction, such as the RCMP

Most scams are outside of Calgary. To report these, contact the appropriate jurisdiction, or the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre, CAFC, for telemarketing, internet, or email scams. CAFC is a reporting agency only.






